DIRECT SCHOOL ADMISSION (DSA) EXERCISE 2024 FOR CLUBS

Clubs encompass a diverse range of interests which are both knowledge-based and skills-based. Participating in a Club CCA sets the stage for our students to expand their exploration, build on their creativity and facilitate a culture of innovation. In the respective Club CCAs, students will learn how to

- use software to create storyboard to animate
- operate a robot or operate and handle PA equipment and devices
- capture and edit photos or videos to collate into a montage

The Clubs have a few milestone activities and events throughout the school year, such as (i) participation in competitions; (ii) organisation of school events such as exhibitions and festival; (iii) attendance at workshops/talks/courses.

APTITUDE Students should preferably have strong interest in Photography & Videography or Animation or Mechatronics, Aeronautics & Robotics.

• CCA ACHIEVEMENT

Students should preferably have represented school in Media & Design or Coding/Robotics or Visual Arts-related competitions or projects in their primary school. Otherwise, students may have some samples of good art and/or media related pieces of work (e.g. short film, animation portfolio, etc.)

• CHARACTER

Students should possess a positive attitude and a sense of commitment in their talent area. They should consistently display exemplary conduct.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who can apply for DSA?

All Primary 6 students can apply for DSA-Sec based on the wide-range of talents offered by the school of their choice.

2. How do I apply?

Application for DSA-Sec can be submitted through the online DSA-Sec Portal. The application is free-of-charge and will be opened from 7 May 2024 to 3 June 2024 (by 3pm). For more details, please refer to MOE website – <u>www.moe.gov.sg/dsa-sec</u>.

- **3. When and how will I know the results of my DSA-Sec application?** All applicants will be informed of the results of their application by email.
- **4. When and how will I know the results of my DSA-Sec allocation results?** Your child's DSA-Sec allocation results will be released along with the PSLE results. Collect the results at your child's primary school.

If your child is not studying in a mainstream primary school, you will receive the DSA-Sec allocation results via email.

5. My child is not in a MOE school. What is the application procedure? The application is made up of 2 parts: (1) Getting a registration number and (2) Accessing the DSA-Sec portal with the given registration number. 6. What is the frequency and duration of training?

Training is conducted usually twice a week for 2.5 hours. However, training hours will be extended during competition or performance periods.
