Dear Parents and Guardians,

Full Home-Based Learning and Other Matters

All schools will shift to Full Home-Based Learning (FHBL) from 19 May to 28 May 2021. During this period students do not report to school for lessons. Instead, teachers will provide instructions and support for students to access a range learning materials (online and/or hardcopy) so that learning continues uninterrupted at home.

Tomorrow, on 18 May, our Form Teachers will provide all students with a FHBL Timetable. This will also be available on our school website. The FHBL Timetable will help students structure their learning from home. They will engage in FHBL from 7.30 am to 1.30 pm, Monday to Friday. Every morning, the Form Teachers will meet with students via Zoom between 7.30 am to 8.00 am to check on their health and well-being. Subject Teachers will also be providing their email contacts so that students can get in touch with them should they need assistance.

7.30 am	Students take daily attendance via Zoom with Form Teachers. Students log into SLS* to check the Daily Assignment Plan.
8.00 am	First lesson begins, with 30min breaks every 1.5 hours.
1.30 pm	Ending time of the last lesson. (There are only 3 lessons each day.)

- We will be postponing the Student Leaders Investiture to July.

- The Parent-Teacher Conference will continue as planned. The booking is available on Parents Gateway from today, 8 am to 24 May, 5 pm. The teachers would have a copy of your child's academic performance for Term 2 and can refer to this in their discussion with you.
- The school will issue the actual hard copy of the Result Slip in Term 3.
