WELCOME & GREETINGS FOR 2021!

Welcome to the start of the new school year! And to the parents/guardians of our new Secondary 1 students, a warm welcome to our Yio Chu Kang Secondary School (YCKSS) family. We hope your child/ward had a good start in week 1 and is looking forward to another exciting year of learning and growth.

1. SEMESTER CALENDAR OF EVENTS

2. SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES

As we are now in Phase 3, we would like to assure you that the following MOE safe management measures continue to be in place to keep all our students and staff safe.

- Daily temperature-taking with additional visual and question screening will continue to be carried out for all students and staff.
- Students and staff who are unwell, or who have adult household members on home quarantine / Stay
 Home Notice or have flu-like symptoms such as fever and cough, will be required to stay away from
 school. They will be placed on Approved Absence and are required to stay at home for the duration of
 the household member's medical leave or until the adult is informed of a negative COVID-19 swab result.
- High-touch surfaces will be cleaned more frequently and the premises disinfected daily.
- Students and staff are required to wear their masks at all times unless engaged in physical activities such as PE or sports CCA. In such cases, there are also strict guidelines restricting interaction.
- Students will practise frequent hand-washing throughout the school day. They will also wipe down of tables and shared equipment after use.
- Intermingling across classes and levels will be minimised.
- There will be fixed exam-style seating in classrooms and spaced seating in canteens or alternative venues.

3. COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS

As part of the school's overall digitalisation efforts, all letters and consent forms will be sent to you via the Parents Gateway (PG) app in 2021 and no hardcopy will be issued unless requested. The PG app will also be used for other purposes, including the booking of timeslot for Parent-Teacher e-Conference and getting parents' consent for activities and programmes.

We would like to encourage you to download and install the app on your mobile phone, and sign in with your SingPass, if you have not already done so. Please also turn on notifications for the PG app and read/acknowledge the latest announcements/consent forms when notified. For parents/guardians who are not eligible to apply for SingPass, hardcopy of the correspondences will continue to be sent to you via your child/ward. 5. TERM 1 WEIGHTED ASSESSMENT
