Short-listed candidates will be informed of the details of their trial and interview via phone or email. At the trial, candidates' level of competencies will be assessed. They will be subjected to physical assessment & testing based on their talent area.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who can apply for DSA?

All Primary 6 students who meet the selection criteria.

2. How do I apply?

3. When and how will I know the results of my application?

4. What is the frequency and duration of training?

Training is conducted usually twice a week for 3 hours. However, training hours will be extended during competition periods.

5. My child is not in a MOE school. What is the application procedure?

Any child not in MOE schools will require a letter issued by MOE HQ at the MOE Customer Service Centre. The letter contains a Registration Number, which he/she can use to apply for the DSA.
